- To introduce participants to main features of non-formal education, different learning styles and different approaches in learning;
- Empower participants to work on topics such as real inclusion, tolerance, fight against discrimination and capacity building, volunteering, youth work, international cooperation, active participation, cultural awareness;
- Increasing participants' abilities to raise and promote inclusion, tolerance, anti-discrimination, equal opportunities and positive social values through non-formal education;
- Empower youth workers to include young people with fewer possibilities in their learning activities, to be able to effectively work with them and provide them with equal treatment as all the other youngsters;
- Foster mutual understanding of certain topics among youth from different cultures, promote intercultural learning;
- Contribute to personal development of participants and improves quality of civil society projects and initiatives;
- Contribute to the recognition and quality development of non-formal education in the youth field in Europe;
- Provide space for networking and developing mutual projects, sharing knowledge and experience on subject between different youth workers;
- Promote Erasmus + programme as tool for cooperation, mobility and learning.
